A visit at the market in Otavalo is a must see. The indigenous bring all there hand crafted textiles, carved stone objects and many other unique items to market. There are row after row of tents sit up to sale their beautiful items. Expect to spend several hours at the market. There are also rows of fresh fruits and vegetables, some I had not hear of before. The ground is very fertile in Ecuador and therefore the crops usually grow very large.
